PUTTING THE STEAM BACK INTO OUR JINTY!

What do we need your support with?

Every steam locomotive has a vital and often large item called a boiler, this contains the steam created by the Fireman for the Driver to use and as a result make the locomotive move!

Without a boiler a steam locomotive has no steam and remains silent, unable to move under it's own power and we can't use the engine to pull our trains. Every 10 years a steam locomotives boiler has to be dismantled for a full inspection and subsequent overhaul, this is to ensure it can then be fit to steam for a further 10 years. Our Jinty's boiler is currently having this overhaul at the North Norfolk Railway.

The Spa Valley Railway has already invested £25,000 into the repairs for 47493's boiler with a further £30,000 already committed. However.... we need <u>YOUR</u> help to finish the repairs and put the steam back into 47493, so join our Jinty Boiler Club today!

We need to raise a further £45,000 towards a range of materials which need to be purchased to keep the repairs going. If everything is successful then the Jinty's boiler will return to Tunbridge Wells West in the Summer of 2021 ready to be placed into the overhauled chassis of the engine.

This will mean that we could, with your help, through the Jinty Boiler Club and your kind sponsorship or donations, see 47493 hauling trains at the Spa Valley Railway again by 2022.

So, what materials do we need?

- Copper Firebox Plate (1 required) £3000.00
- Steel Firebox Sides (2 required) £1150.00 each
- Steel Firebox Throat Plate (1 required) £1000.00
- Smokebox Tubeplate Angle Ring (1 required) £7260.00
- Copper Firebox Stays (530 required). £30.00 each
- Copper Firebox Patch Screws (90 required). £60.00 each
- Boiler Tubes (194 required) £25.00 each
- Washout Plugs (20 required) £50.00 each

How can you help?

We need our Jinty to return to steam by 2022 to help pull our trains, not only is returning 47493 to steam vital to our future success, this locomotive will become our first Society owned mainline steam locomotive to operate on our railway!

We are asking for your help, either in the form of a donation to our Jinty Boiler Club, or that you consider sponsoring one of (or multiples there of) the components listed on the previous page. Whilst these components are hidden well within the locomotive when we put 47493 back together, you will in, either case, be in the sound knowledge that you put the steam back into our Jinty!
